

St. George Greek Orthodox Church Community Scholarship Application

The scholarship program at Saint George Greek Orthodox Church is provided on an annual basis to promote and support the educational aspirations of the youth of the church. Different types of scholarships can be awarded. These are based on academic merit, need and perseverance in overcoming a life hardship. Each of these scholarships requires all applicants to demonstrate significant church and community involvement.

Application & Instruction Information Sheet

A. ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

1. The applicant must be a graduating high school senior, accepted to attend a community college, state college, university or trade school, or is enrolled and attending such institutions.
2. The applicant will have a minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 at the school he/she currently attends (this requirement may be waived if a financial need is demonstrated or student has overcome a substantial life hardship). If this is applicable to you, please submit additional information explaining financial need or hardship.
3. An applicant currently attending a college or university must be enrolled in a minimum of 9 units.
4. The applicant or his/her immediate family is a member in good standing of the St. George Greek Orthodox Church - Fresno.
5. The complete application, including transcripts and letters of recommendation, must be post marked by the deadline, Monday, May 10, 2021.
6. Priority will be given to those applicants who have not been a prior recipient of this scholarship.

B. CRITERIA USED FOR JUDGING THE APPLICANTS

Each completed scholarship application is eligible based on the criteria below:

1. Academic achievement, demonstrated financial need or demonstrated ability to overcome substantial life hardship
2. Leadership and service in the community, school and church
3. Strength of essay

INSTRUCTIONS TO APPLICANTS

Application Submittal Checklist:

1. SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FORM FULLY COMPLETED
2. OFFICIAL HIGH SCHOOL OR COLLEGE TRANSCRIPT IN A SEALED ENVELOPE WITH REGISTRAR'S STAMP
3. WRITTEN RECOMMENDATION LETTERS - ONE FROM EACH CATEGORY
 - a. FROM TEACHER OR ADMINISTRATOR
 - b. FROM A COMMUNITY MEMBER (NOT A PRIEST) i.e. organizations, volunteer work, workplace, etc.
1. ALL RESPONSES ON THE APPLICATION FORM SHALL BE PRINTED IN INK OR TYPED ON THE ORIGINAL FORM PROVIDED. PLEASE DO NOT ADD TO THE FORM
2. APPLICATIONS MUST BE SENT BY CERTIFIED MAIL, POSTMARKED NO LATER THAN MONDAY, MAY 10, 2021

DISBURSEMENT OF FUNDS

It is the responsibility of the award recipient to provide the Scholarship Committee with written evidence of enrollment in a minimum of 9 units prior to September 30, 2021.

FAILURE TO PROVIDE PROOF OF ENROLLMENT BY THAT DATE WILL RESULT IN FORFEITURE OF THE AWARD.

Each award will be disbursed on receipt of proof of enrollment and will be awarded only for the current academic school year. The award cannot be deferred.

In the event the recipient loses eligibility prior to disbursement of the award, the award will be granted to the first runner up.

FINAL DECISION

The Scholarship Committee will notify the recipients by June 14, 2021 .

The Scholarship Committee reserves the right to make the final decision on the award recipient.
